## The Meek/Meeks Family

Groups G Introduction

**William M. Meeks** was born about 1798 in South Carolina. By 1830 he lived in Fairview Division/Township, Greenville Co., SC where he owned and planted about 176 acres of land north of the Reedy River near the Laurens Co., SC border. He married (1) **Jane Thompson** 28 Dec 1820. She was born 31 Jan 1804. She died 18 Sep 1853. He was listed in the 1830 to 1880 censuses of Greenville Co., SC.

Multiple descendants from 2 different sons have 37 marker Y-DNA tests which support this line back to William Meeks. The Y-DNA profile includes a RecLoH event at DYS385. The STR signature indicates a haplogroup/SNP within the R-L21 branch of P312 and matches a sub-group known as "MacWho" which has not yet been identified by SNP.

The Group G Y-DNA signature is unique within the Meek Project. The progenitor, William Meeks was not related to other early Meek(s) ancestors whose descendants have been tested. A man in one group cannot be related to men in other groups. Y-DNA testing on their descendants excludes the possibility that William was William Sheridan Meeks, the son of Littleton Meeks.
